

Walk Instructions:

Start on the north side of Chatsworth Road at the pedestrian crossing near Heaton Street. Follow the footpath north, cross Old Road and pick up the path opposite to walk alongside Brampton Manor. As you come out onto the Manor Estate turn left to take the path into the Inkerman. Stay along the bottom of the field to join Manor Road (after wandering up into the Inkerman to look at the new playground).

At the end of Manor Road cross Ashgate Avenue to take the track to look at Manor Fields. Retrace your steps, turn right and go down the avenue to turn right onto Old Road. Cross the road and then take the unnamed road first left after McMillan Mews. Keep straight on as the road becomes a path which comes out onto Westfield Close. Keep right and walk to the end of Vincent Crescent. At the end cross Storrs Road into Upper Moor Street, at the end bear right and follow the footpath signs to take you across the back of the Brookfield School campus.

Keep the to the left and after the Scout Hut cross to the small wood at the opposite corner of the field. Go through the kissing gate and into another field, which may have livestock. Keep the fence close on your left and in the corner of the field climb over a small stile and turn left to follow the path until it emerges at the corner of Westbrook Drive and Chatsworth Road.

Cross Chatsworth Road via the refuge and follow the finger post to pick up the path by a stream. Keep on this path through Somersall Farm until you come to a T-junction where you turn left. When the path reaches Somersall Lane, turn left and after the bridge, cross the lane to enter Somersall Park.

Walk through the park on the main path, turn right over the river bridge, keep on the path as it veers left through the playing fields and then bear left, then right, following the blue finger posts for Hipper Valley to enter Walton Dam. The path follows a stream and then opens out onto the bank of the dam. Follow the path until it emerges onto Walton Road. Turn left then left again after Morrison's roundabout onto Chatsworth Road to arrive back at your starting point.

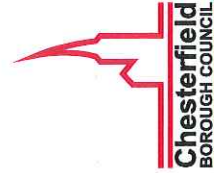

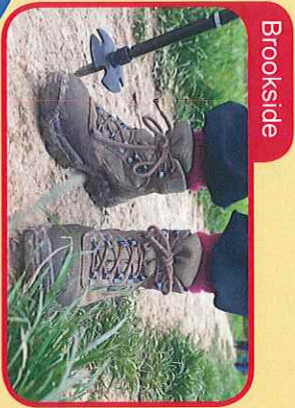
